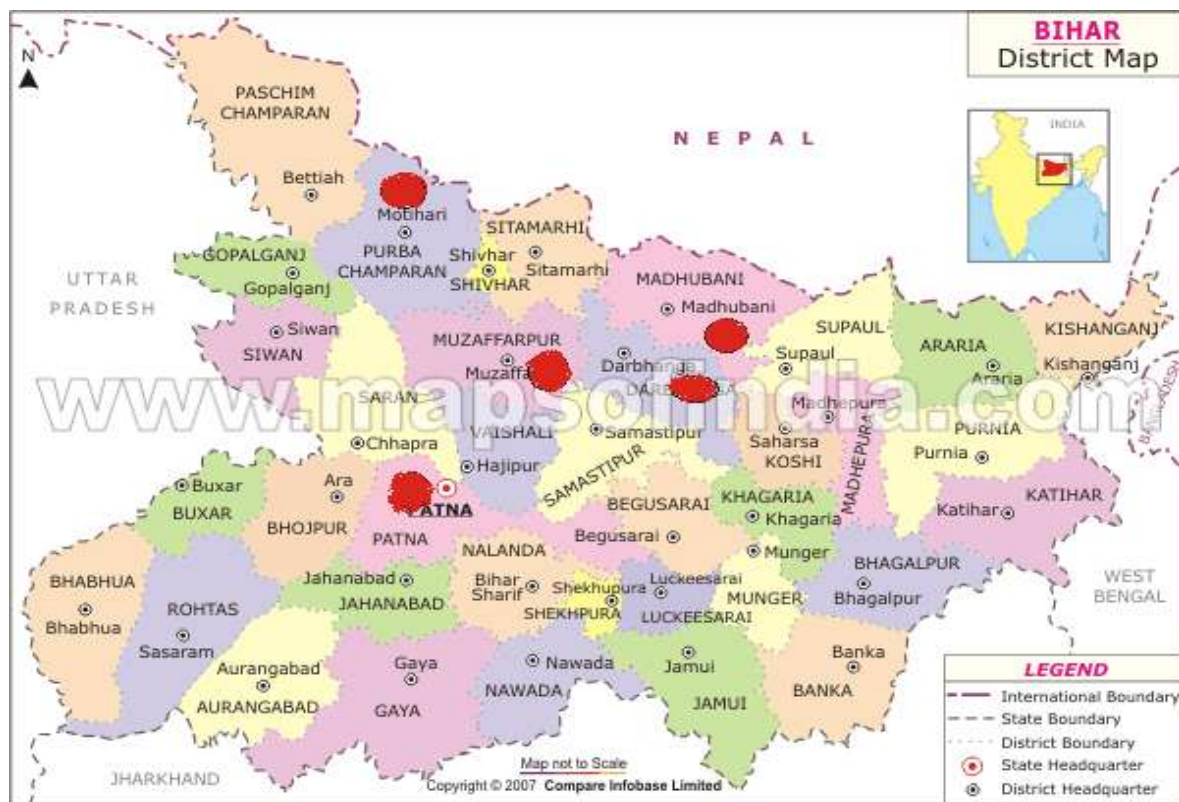

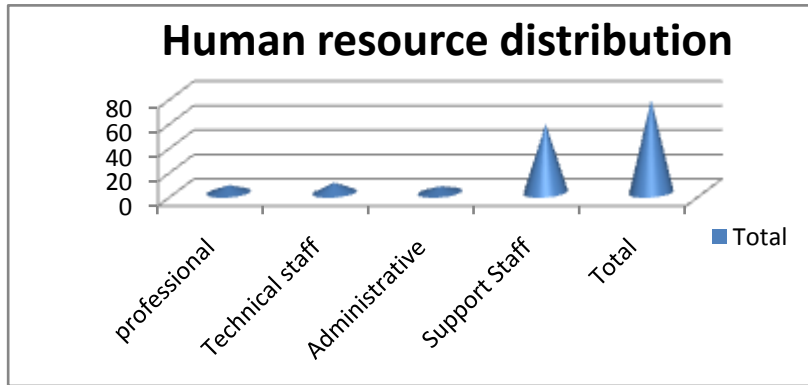
## Description in Map highlighting the district

## Project details for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015

### 1) Water Aid India

Project Title - Facilitating SAKHI Fisher woman cooperative member's access to Sanitation entitlement

Objectives -

- To facilitate access to safe water sanitation services to Fisher women Cooperative/SHG Members
- To support and capacitate the Community Leaders to facilitate access of all government WASH schemes
- Female Hygiene chain at Community Level capacitated

In this program the main focus is improvement of WASH access & facilities in the community. to generate awareness and sensitize the community our main volunteer is children's and women of the community. We have formed 34 Bal Swachta Dal covering all 25 Gram Panchayat and having total member 680. These members were trained on the issues of WASH and they act as brand ambassador of the project. They orient other children of the schools on the proper WASH practices. This helps in the improvement of Hand washing during mid day meal and improvement in the health of the children. We are building capacity of the women and adolescent girls on the issue of menstrual health management. Till date more than 400 women and girls were oriented on the issue and they were supporting & generating other members of the community on the same issue. This helps in increase in attendance of the girl children in the schools.

Apart from that more than 2000 toilets constructed this year by the community which helps in improving the status of women and girl members of the community.

### 2) Global Sanitation Fund

Aim:- to make 17 panchayat of the Jhanjharpur block ODF

Last year work:-

- Formation and strengthening of VHSNC
- Formation of BSD
- Awareness generation in all 17 panchayat on the issue of sanitation.
- Convergence of the government schemes.

With the support of the global sanitation fund our team works for the improvement of sanitation status of the Jhanjharpur block. We are mobilizing the community, PRIs as well as government officials for the development of the sanitation status of the Jhanjharpur block. During this program our volunteers are school children, PRIs members. Till date more than 6000 IHHL constructed by community supporting more than 36000 population to live their life in dignity.

Outcome:-

- 3 Village & 8 Wards become ODF
- More than 3 villages on the verge of becoming ODF

Target till Dec 16

17 Panchayat become ODF

### **3) Women Development corporation:-**

Aim :- to provide safe shelter and vocational training to the women victims of society.

Sakhi is managing Short Stay Home for women & girl victims of the society with the support of women development corporation, Bihar. This year SSH provided support to many victims and rehabilitated them back to the normal life. During their stay in the SSH we are providing them the vocational training on different aspect so that they could stand on their own feet after they got rehabilitated. The major work performed in the short stay home is counseling of the victims, legal support, vocational training, and rehabilitation & follow up for their well being. Till date we have provided safe home to more than 230 victims and our effort is going on.

### **4) Major activities of Sakhi training & resource center:-**

Sakhi Training & resource center has the capacity of providing residential training to the 50 members

- Provided training space to ICAR, IWMI, CIMMYT, IDE.

5) **Research and Documentation:**

- a) **IWMI (ACIAR) supported research project of land water resource management:-** in this project we are supporting 45 marginal & tenant farmers to go for the dry season cropping so that they could improve their economic & social condition by judicious use of water. Here training provided to the farmers on vegetable cultivation, crop management, group management. The activities are conducted in two mode, cooperative farming mode and individual mode. During Rabi season 45 farmers take up the activity of lentil, wheat & potato cultivation.
- b) **CIMMYT (ACIAR) supported research project of soil conservation & crop diversification:-** in this project we are working with 26 male & female farmers on soil conservation & crop diversification. The farmer uses new technology of Zero tillage, rice transplanter for soil conservation. Our effort is now visible and our plan is to replicate this technology with other farmers of the area.
- c) **ILRT supported research project of enhanced fish production when farmers got assurance of pond security:-** here we are working with 20 pond owners by providing them security by the secretary of the cooperative that until rent is paid on time secretary will not take pond.

6) **Networking with Other Organization :**

- SAKHI is coordinating agency of Cross Border Anti trafficking Network (CBATN).
- SAKHI is active member of URJA network which is Bihar women's leaders' network.
- SAKHI is part of National Fish Forum.
- Member of Bihar Inter Agency Group.









7) **Influencing policy at different levels:**

With support of the GSF and Water Aid India raised the issue of the sanitation at the block/district as well as at the state level and this issue is of importance for the department and instruction given by the department to take proper attention on the issue.
